Building Great Relationships in Your Home Ephesian 6:1-4 Pastor Brent McDougal

Great relationships don't just happen. They require effort. But the rewards are worth it. This series of messages is about how to have great relationships through God's wisdom.

Last week we talked about building great friendships and looked at the qualities of true friends. They have faith when you don't, choose to go together, forgive quickly, and share Jesus with others.

Today's focus is on how to build great relationships in your family.

Great families ______ to one another.

"Let the wise hear and increase in learning, and the one who understands obtain guidance..." (Proverbs 1:5, ESV).

"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says" (James 1:22, NIV).

Great families ______ one another.

"Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other" (Romans 12:10, NLT).

Great families don't exasperate one another to the point of ______.

"A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger" (Proverbs 15:1, ESV).

"Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another" (Galatians 5:26, ESV).

Great families ______ life with one another.

"There is nothing better for a person than that he should eat and drink and find enjoyment in his toil. This also, I saw, is from the hand of God..." (Ecclesiastes 2:24, ESV).

"I concluded there is nothing better than to be happy and enjoy ourselves as long as we can. And people should eat and drink and enjoy the fruits of their labor, for these are gifts from God" (Ecclesiastes 3:12-13, NLT).

"This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it" (Psalm 118:24, ESV).
