We Welcome Dr. George Schweitzer, September 15

Dr. Schweitzer earned his B.A. in Chemistry from Central College in 1945, his M.S. in Chemistry from the University of Illinois in 1946, and his Ph.D. in Chemistry from the University of Illinois in 1948. Dr. Schweitzer also earned an M.A. in Philosophy from Columbia University in 1959, a Ph.D. in Philosophy from New York University in 1964, and was awarded a Sc.D. for his work in the history of science in 1965. He joined the faculty at the University of Tennessee in 1948, and has done and continues to do research and consult with several of the facilities at Oak Ridge: K-25, Y-12, ORNL, ORAU, AEC, UT-AEC, and ARP. [Dr. Schweitzer] has been the recipient of numerous awards, fellowships, and lectureships, including a National Science Foundation Faculty Fellowship (1959-60). Schweitzer is an alumni distinguished professor at the University of Tennessee and is the author of 19 genealogical guidebooks.
