Welcome Dr. Ken Roxburgh October 13, 20, & 27

Dr. Roxburgh went to Samford from Scottish Baptist College in Glasgow, Scotland, where he served as president and taught. He received his B.A. from the London School of Theology, his M.Th. from Aberdeen University, and his Ph.D. from Edinburgh University.

Dr. Roxburgh researches the History of Christianity in Scotland in the 20th century. He has written numerous articles for scholarly journals, as well as a book, "Thomas Gillespie and the Origins of the Relief Church in 18th Century Scotland" (Peter Lang, 1999). At Samford, Dr. Roxburgh teaches Baptist History and Theology, Christian Theology, Pastoral Theology, and Contemporary Theology.
