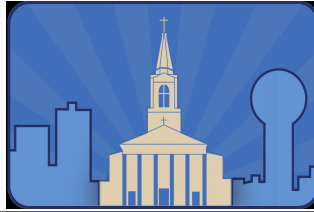

Sunday, January 26: Coffee and Conversation with the Candidate and Committee – 8:45 am to 9:45 am in Blue Room

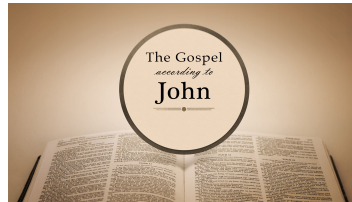
Sunday, January 26: Combined Worship Service followed by Called Business Session and Vote – 11 am to 12 pm in Sanctuary
