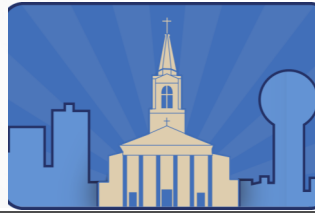

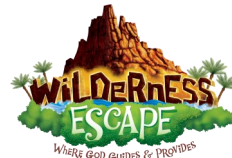


### The Lord's Prayer

### Quarterly Business Meeting Next Week

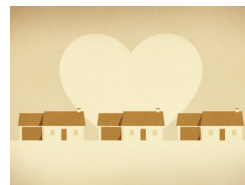
