Preschool Ministry COVID Guidelines

(Babies - Kindergarten)



Sunday Morning Procedures

Preschool ChildCare for ages 3 and under is available for both the 8:45 am service and the 11 am service.

Sunday School, from 9:45 - 10:45 am, is also available for ages birth through Kindergarten.

- Temperature checks are required for all teachers and children. Temperatures 99.0 or higher will not be able to enter a Classroom.
- Caterpillar Cove (first floor) will be a MASK ONLY ZONE.

Face Masks are **required for all adults**, including DROP OFF AND PICK UP.



DROP-OFF

- We ask that only 1 adult bring the Child to the preschool floor.
- Proceed to the Check-In Table. The lobby area will not be open at this time.
- Please observe the social distancing marks on the floor.



- Temperature checks will be taken at the Check-In Table.
- Cell phone numbers will be recorded by a volunteer.
- A name tag will be written out and placed on your child.
- Children's hands will be sanitized.
- Your child will be escorted to their Classroom by a volunteer. Parents will be able to exit the floor at that time and will not be allowed in the Classroom. (See procedure for babies- 2 year.)
- Please bring only necessary items for your child. Coats, jackets, and sweaters should be kept and taken by the adult dropping off the child. Please do not bring any toys or stuffed animals from home. Essential items will be kept in a cubby or in a basket.

PICK-UP

- The same adult that dropped off your child should return to the Check-In Table for pick-up.
- Adults will remain at the Check-In Table while a volunteer brings your Child back from their Classroom. Please maintain social distancing while waiting.

PARENTS OF BABIES- 2 YEAR OLDS

- You will follow the same procedures listed above. However, you will be allowed to dropoff and pick-up your child at the door of their classroom. (A100 or D100)
- A teacher will receive your child at the door. Adults are not allowed to enter the room.
- Essential items needed for your Child (diaper, pacifier, bottle) should be clearly labeled and brought in a gallon-sized ziplock bag with the Child's name on the front. These will be left in the basket labeled for your child outside the classroom door.
- Diaper bags will be taken with you.
